

# Accessibility

## General Areas

### Summary

Willen Lake comprises of a mixture of open grass space, gravel paths, paved paths and lightly wooded areas. There are wide, surfaced paths around both lakes and leisure areas.

### Entrance and access

All designated entrances to the park are flat and either paved or gravel paths. Any changes in path heights are ramped. Access is either via step-free tarmacked surfaces from our car parks, or via the Milton Keynes City Council redway network which provides wide and flat access across the city.

### Toilets

There are several public toilets on site, each with an accessible toilet and baby changing facility. These are situated in the following locations:

- Watersports Centre (open all year round, times vary depending on season)
- Willen Lake Café (open during operating hours for paying customers)
- Splash 'n' Play (open April to October only)

We also have a Changing Places facility located at the Watersports Centre.

### Activities

#### Walking/cycling

At present, it is not possible to travel around the north and south lakes using surfaced paths. We hope to connect a surfaced loop around the whole site in the future.

#### Bird hide

Access to the bird hide is only accessible via a woodchip path.

#### Leisure activities
