

# Accessibility

## Archery

### Summary

Our Archery activity welcomes disabled visitors and visitors with additional needs, but we require reasonable advanced notice. Please read this guide carefully to understand if Archery is suitable for you. Each activity has strict safety requirements. Our staff will be happy to discuss individual requirements either by phone or on site prior to your visit.

### Entrance and access

The archery activity takes place in our archery paddock which is located approximately 900m from our Watersports Centre. The archery paddock itself is grass and may be uneven in places.

### Parking

Archery is located 400m from the nearest car park. This contains accessible parking bays.

### Toilets

The nearest accessible toilet is situated at Splash 'n' Play, which is approximately 700 metres away. The nearest Changing Places facility is located at the Watersports Centre, which is approximately 600 metres away.

### Activities

#### Archery

Archery requires use of upper body and arms, and due to the nature of the activity, it is important that individuals can follow instructions and safety briefings.
